Approximately 7.6 million people in the UK have heart or circulatory diseases, and around 80% of those people have at least one other health condition. To ensure the healthcare workforce is able to meet the future demands of the NHS, it is key that health and care professionals have up to date knowledge of cardiovascular disease (CVD).

Who is this course for?

This course is designed for health and care professionals who are supporting patients with conditions under the CVD umbrella. The course is also ideal for HCPs supporting people with co-morbidities, and therefore looking to refresh their knowledge and update their clinical practice.

Course content:

The course comprises of two online webinars, each two-hours in length. These are led by an experienced clinical specialist and supported by a course facilitator. The sessions are highly interactive and take place over an eight week period. Learners are also encouraged to undertake brief research or quality improvement initiatives between the two webinar sessions.
